

# Transatlantic Climate Bridge Student Essay Contest

*Creating just transitions in Canada, Germany & the United States*

**€500 prize**

**Eligibility:** This essay contest is open to all **currently enrolled undergraduate and master program students** studying at a university in **Canada, Germany or the United States**. We will select three winning essays, one from each country.

**Prompt:** The prompt for all students relates to **just transitions** in each country and how **experiences from one can relate to the others**

- **Prompt for students in Canada:** How can Canada make its climate change and energy transition a just transition? Compare and contrast the concept of a just transition in Canada to a just transition in Germany.
- **Prompt for students in Germany:** How can Germany make its climate change and energy transition a just transition? Compare and contrast the concept of a just transition in Germany to a just transition in Canada and/or the US.
- **Prompt for students in the United States:** How can the US make its climate change and energy transition a just transition? Compare and contrast the concept of a just transition in the US to a just transition in Germany.

**Length:** 800 – 1200 words

**Deadline:** 15 May 2022, 23:59 CET
